It was good talking with you the other day; I'll send the exhibition info. as soon as it's together.

Thought you might like to see the enclosed — Metropolis magazine (architecture monthly) did this follow up on Adam Purple. The "disaffected" teenagers they write about are "the Ringston School", and they are responsible for the welded sculpture you see in the photo. Their work is the antithesis of Purple's — their intent is to be aggressive, ugly, etc. I'm not sure if they have art school training or not, and if they have artistic pretensions generally — they're not hospitable folk. Adam says they get \$ from their parents and drink all day:

Soon or later Bob & I will do a good follow-up interview with Purple. Last I heard, a NYC folklore group, CITYLORE, was going to produce postcards of "Endangered Spaces," including those already lost — like the Garden of Eden.
