Lake County is located only seventy minutes north of Grand Rapids on M-37. The County Seat is Baldwin – Home of the world famous Shrine of the Pines and National Brown Trout Capital. Nearby Bitely hosts World-Championship Snowmobile water races, while Idlewild is a fascinating historical resort area. In the north, Irons is famous for its snowmobiling and the unique Flea Roast and Ox Market. Luther is home of the "Luther Loggers," and Cross Country Skiing. Chase and Carr settlements are farm and lumber communities. Branch is the ending point for most canoe trips on the famous Pere Marquette River.




