



The NSU Folk Art Center and Sculpture Garden is near Chauvin in the Parish of Terrebonne, Louisiana, on the left descending bank of Bayou Petit Caillou. About 19 miles below Houma, Louisiana, it is roughly 90 minutes south of New Orleans.



From New Orleans, take I - 310 West, then Exit I - 130 via ramp at sign reading "US-90 W to Houma". Tum right and go southwest. (22 miles)

You will see a sign reading "US-90 to LA-3198/HOUMA/RACELAND". Bear right on ramp to BUS US-90 W (LA-3198 W) and merge with caution. (0.3 miles)

You will see a sign reading "US-90 W to HOUMA". Take BUS US-90 W (LA-3198 W) Ramp and merge with caution. (< 0.1 mile)

Turn left onto BUS US-90 W (LA-3198 W) and go Southwest for 0.32 miles to BUS US-90 W. (0.3 miles)

Continue onto BUS US-90 W and go Southwest for 7.9 miles to LA-24 (Main St). (7.9 miles)

Tum left onto LA-24 (Main St) and go East for 5.2 miles to LA-56 (Main St). (5.2 miles)

Continue onto LA-56 (Main St) and go Southeast for 0.74 miles to LA-56. (0.7 miles)

Continue onto LA-56 and go Southeast. (10.0 miles)

Turn left at stop light intersection (Chevron station on right) and cross Bayou Petit Caillou.

Turn right onto Bayouside Drive to 5337 Bayouside Drive; Folk Art Center will be to your left, Sculpture Garden on your right.
