-- NOT-for-PROFIT CORPORATION --

- 3. Assist in the development of the appropriate 501 (c) 3 documents for submittal to the Federal Government, Internal Revenue Service.

-- BOARD & STAFF DEVELOPMENT --

- 1. Assist in the Creation of the JOB DESCRIPTION for the Board and/or Fund Raising (Development) Committee:
 - a. Create a job description outlining the responsibilities and duties of members;
 - b. Create a membership application for prospective members;
 - c. Assist in the creation of an outline for the board/committee for the needs of the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT; and,
 - d. Develop an outline for an Advisory Committee including their responsibilities and duties.

- 2. Prepare and conduct ORIENTATIONS (Retreats) for the Board, Staff, Committees and Special Friends of the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT
- 3. Meet with the appropriate members of the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT to develop a CAMPAIGN for the Fund Raising (Development) Committee and/or Board of Directors recruitment needs:
 - a. Assist in the research and cultivation of prospective candidates;
 - b. Assist in the recruitment of prospective Fund Raising (Development) Committee and/or Board of Directors; and,

PAYMENT of the monthly retainer for and beyond MONTH TEN (10) of the current year shall constitute an automatic extension of this agreement. ALL EXPENSES incurred that are related to the fulfillment of the services rendered to be reimbursed within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice.

NOTE:

- 01. LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT representative will give prior approval to go beyond the "monthly hours" in any given month.
- 02. Reimbursed expenses above \$500.00 (US) to receive prior approval from the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT representative.
- 03. Hold all communications both written and oral CONFIDENTIAL unless otherwise authorized by Kelleher & Associates.
- 04. Supply Kelleher & Associates all pertinent information and data on the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT.
- 05. Designate the appropriate contact(s) from the LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT who will be the individual(s) to communicate and assist Kelleher & Associates.
- 06. LAS POZAS CONSERVATION PROJECT will provide support staff when needed to execute the overall development campaign.
