The Humboldt Arts Council was founded on February 8, 1966, under the leadership of Dr. Homer Balabanis, Emeritus Vice President, Humboldt State University. Dr. Balabanis stated, "The Humboldt Arts Council will work to stimulate and aid art talent and activities throughout the county in all ways and endeavor to make such activity a vital influence in the life of the community".

Its Purpose

The Humboldt Arts Council, a California nonprofit corporation, is dedicated by charter to promoting cultural awareness and advancement of all forms of the arts in Humboldt County.

HAC members are individuals, organizations, and businesses who share in the support and encouragement of all forms of the arts, including music, drama, dance and the visual arts.


