Many thanks for your recent letter which outlines the disposition of works of art by the late John Ehn. I am pleased with the selections coming to The Oakland Museum, but must express some disappointment that the busts of John Ehn and Mary Ehn (S26 & S 24) that were exhibited in The Oakland Museum's exhibition Cat and Ball on a Waterfall were not assigned to us. In this regard, might S27, an unpainted bust of John Ehn, be available? We would very much like a sculptural piece that could be prominently displayed on a pedestal in addition to the small wall pieces.

Also, I noticed that S12, Face plaque: Marianne with long braid, has been assigned to both The Oakland Museum and the Kohler Art Center. It is a piece we would like to include in the collection.
