We are very interested in the plans for restoration and maintenance of The Watts Towers, and hope you will keep us informed.

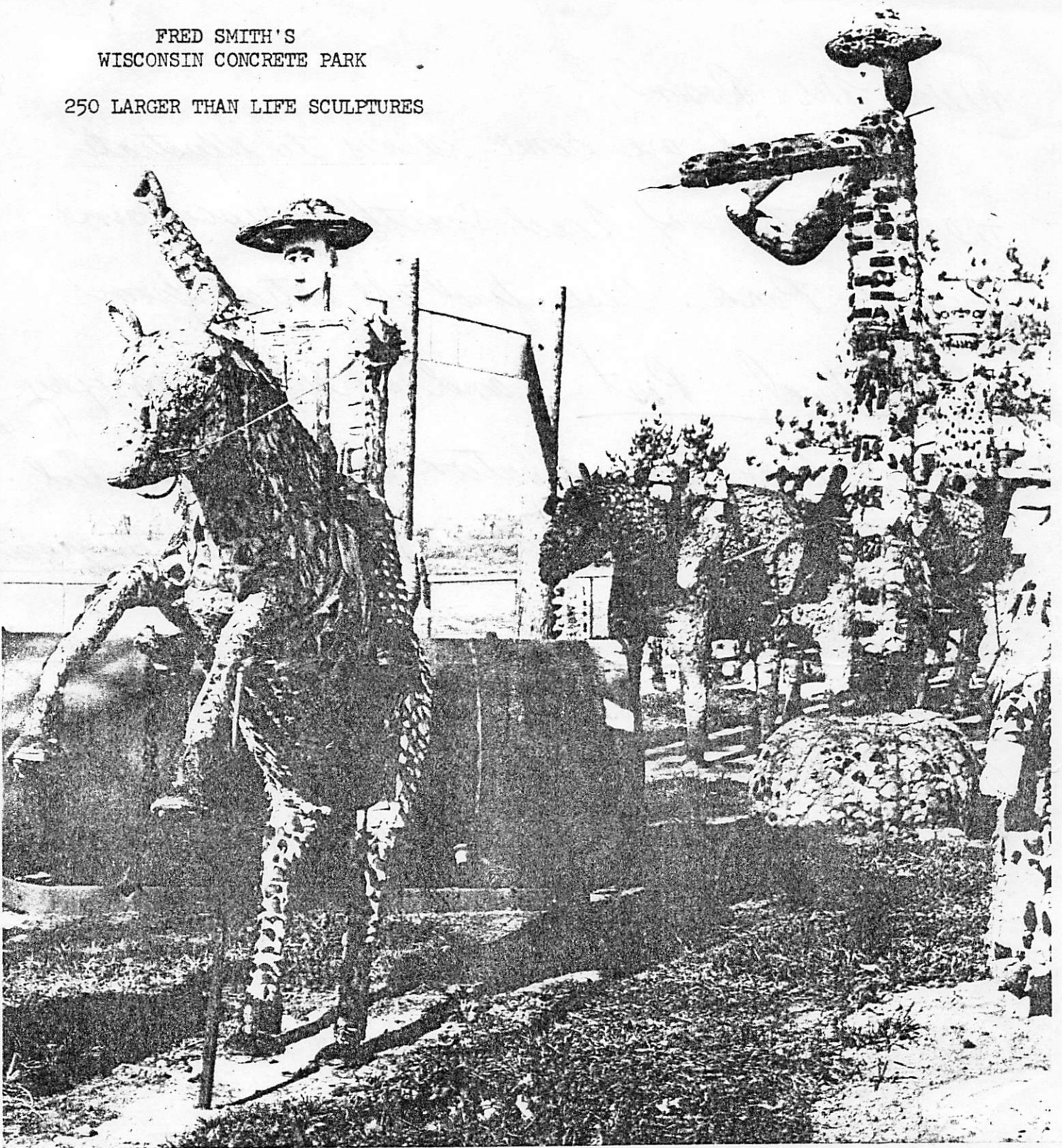
