GARDEN OF EDEN

S.P. Dinsmoor (1843-1932) built his "Stone Log Cabin" of cut and fitted native limestone logs, one being 27 feet long. He built a "Garden of Eden" in the yard of concrete (113 tons by 1927), a Goddess of Liberty, Adam and Eve, The Devil, The Crucifixion of Labor, angels, birds, and many other things. Mr. Dinsmoor is buried in the mausoleum (far left) with his first wife. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
