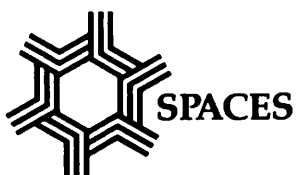

If you are comfortable with this, please call Mel Tearle and find a time good for you both.


