

ADMIRAL NIMITZ STATE HISTORICAL PARK

340 East Main Street Fredericksburg, Texas

This unusual museum, operated by the State of Texas, consists of several units:

 The Steamboat Hotel, which contains the Museum of the Pacific War, dedicated to everyone who served in the Pacific under Admiral Nimitz.

2. The Garden of Peace, a beautiful, restful spot behind the hotel, gift from the people of Japan.

3. The History Walk of the Pacific War, a block from the garden, displays rare relics—planes, guns, boats, tanks, from the Pacific War.

4. The Nimitz Art Gallery, next to the Steamboat Hotel on Main Street, displays combat art and/or photography. Museum headquarters are in this building.

Hours: 8 a.m.- 5 p.m. daily

Admission: Adults, \$2.00; 6-12 yrs., \$1.00; under 6, free.

The museum theme is patriotism, love of country and the sacrifices made to preserve the freedom Americans enjoy.

Motto: We inspire our youth by honoring our heroes.
