Charter for Holy Land U.S.A.



This charter is enacted for the purpose of serving Holy Land U.S.A. in Waterbury, Connecticut, so that it may continue to promote better knowledge of the Scriptures and also to inspire people to meditate on the commandment that Christ gave at the Last Supper: "This is My commandment - that you love one another. By the fulfillment of this commandment it shall be known that you are My disciple." In this spirit, Holy Land Chapters shall function for the following purposes:

To encourage tourists to make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land in Connecticut.

To bring the spirit of Holy Land U.S.A. to many tourists - that such chapters may proliferate and increase the godliness of our existence.

To maintain constant ties with the Holy Land office in Connecticut that progress and development may be brought to the attention of an interested public.

To organize a Communications Committee within the chapter, headed by the Communications Coordinator whose function will serve the vital need of publicity and public relations. This shall include a mailing of a news release to local newspapers and broadcast stations. It will regard the activities of Holy Land chapter involvement. The Committee will assist in the distribution of broadcast material as programs and spots that relate to the historical and educational significance of Holy Land, as well as any inspirational functions that may take place at the chapter level.
