Enclosed is a copy of the sheet from the National Register showing the date when the Bottle House was listed.

I noted after getting off the phone with you yesterday that your bulletin no. 4 refers to a field survey form you ve developed. Can you send me one? It would help to know what information you are seeking for a particular site.

We are in the process of working on a guidebook to Michigan architecture that is to be part of a national set of architectural guidebooks published by Oxford University Press under the auspices of the Society of Architectural Historians. As part of this project, several interns are beating the bushes for material to include. Much of the state has barely been touched by murvey efforts. The work has turned up several grottos — in Detroit, Westphalia (NW of Lansing), and South Haven (Lake Michigan shore across from Chicago). In due course I'll be able to get you decent photos and info for them. The Detroit one appears in an 1880s book (copy of info enclosed) — rumor has it the place still exists and looks much the same.

I'll keep you in mind for other places that seem to fit your purposes.
