Dear Members,

We thought things would slow down as the holidays approached, but it hasn't happened yet. We just finished participating in three exhibitions which featured environments. In two of the exhibitions, "Joyful Visions" at the Craft and Folk Art Museum, Los Angeles, and "A Time to Reap" at Seton Hall, New Jersey, SPACES contributed photographs, histories of sites and some consultation. The exhibition "Divine Disorder: California Folk Art Environments" at the Triton Museum, Santa Clara, California, was wholly a SPACES's project, from photographs, site plans and text, to hauling and schlepping artifacts from the sites. All our members should have received announcements for this exhibit. We are now trying to arrange for the photographs from "Divine Disorder" to travel around California and perhaps beyond.

In the works for March 1986 is "Folk's Art" an exhibition for the Oakland Museum which will contain an as yet undetermined number of California environments.

Also in the works is the nomination to State Landmark status of John Medica's Garden (castles, bridges, walkways, plantings on a 4 acre site), and the development of a community trust to protect John's property.

Newsletter #3 will contain a checklist of exhibitions which have included environments, and will be in your mailbox by Spring 1986. If you have current information about folk art environments to share with us -- especially about exhibitions for the checklist -- please contact us.

To do our job, to meet SPACES's goals and obligations, we need the support of a membership constituency. Government and private funders need to know that SPACES has the support of a community of members. If all our members renew for 1986 we can keep the basic membership rate at \$10.
