This film will take you on an extraordinary journey into the world of the Surrealists as the life and

accomplishments of the Surrealist collector, poet and architect Edward James unfolds. For the last

least known architectural monuments of the 20th century, dedicated to Surrealism and hidden in the

Walking through Los Posas, it is sometimes hard to see where the jungle ends and the concrete structures begin, they are blended so well with the environment. James was truly an eccentric and it shows in all of his works. The habitat is bordered by a river where large pools well up in several places; a refreshing respite for the local folk.

The structures are enigmatic. Stairs go up and end in nothingness. Some go up just to return to the earth, while others are blocked at the top. The concrete columns, 15 feet

high and less than 6 inches in diameter, blow in the breeze and sway as birds alight on them. All the concrete was poured from wooden molds, handcrafted by the craftsmen in Xilitla. Because James and Plutarco were so into perfection, these delicate structures have lasted this long.

The paths weave throughout the area, with seemingly organic buildings rising into the air. Many of these buildings have

names, such as

"Homage To Max Ernst", "House of Three Stories That Might Be Five", and " Plaza Don Eduardo". There is a lot of water, which is always a place for another one of James' creations. James died in the mid 80's, leaving his legacy, which has been said to be "among the significant creative works of man". Next
