CANADA GEESE (*Branta canadensis*)

The famous V-formations of Canada geese are familiar sights from the Arctic coast to the Gulf of Mexico as the flocks migrate from winter to summer ranges and back again—honking happily all the way. The abundant waterfowl prefer to nest in open marshes and on grassy islands, where they raise their broods of down-covered goslings on insects, snails and vegetable matter. These long-necked adults may have wingspreads of up to 5½' and be up to 3½' long. For a welcome in-flight stopover, the birds delight in a corn stubblefield or patch of meadow grasses.

The wildlife scene on this card serves as a reminder of the beauty of nature . . . of our need to promote an appreciation for wildlife . . . and of the importance of the conservation and wise use of all our natural resources.
