CURATOR'S STATEMENT: "A TRIBUTE TO LITTO",

POPE VALLEY'S HUBCAP KING

The first time I drove past Litto's place I was thrilled, dazzled by the glitter and shine of a fence full of aluminum hubcaps, strongly contrasting with, yet somehow enhancing the rural setting. Here was something unusual and unexpected, something worth stopping for ... I had discovered Litto.

He was a strong individualist, a unique personality with a powerful sense of himself, but he didn't consider himself an artist, and certainly not a "folk artist". During his lifetime, Litto collected more than 3,000 hubcaps, as well as a vast array of signs and other items which most people would have consigned to the refuse heap. Instead, he shaped them into his own creation, arranging them as he saw fit. As he himself said in an interview with "Smithsonian Magazine", "This is my place; Litto's place. It's nobody's but mine. You can travel all you want (and) you don't see no hubcap ranch, no hubcap king."

Our "Tribute to Litto" represents a small part of his hubcap/artwork collection, as well as many personal items; photographs, ties, and other momentos of a long and productive life. It also includes a photographic tribute to Litto, his ranch, and life as recorded by seven local photographers.

To me, Litto's creative character represents the essence of art, a purity of purpose and vision that typify the true artist, regardless of what he may call himself. Through the encouragement of admirers and working with his family, Litto became a vital part of his community, and never lost sight of his goal. Hubcap ranch exists because, for Litto, it had to.
